Tri-State's current standard offer avoided cost (composite value on a \$/MWh basis reflecting monthly off-peak and on-peak pricing) for projects of 1.0 MW or less is as follows:

2024	\$24.03
2025	\$34.33
2026	\$ 9.02
2027	\$ 6.34
2028	\$ 0.11

These figures are calculated using hourly chronological production cost methods to determine the hourly energy cost at the system level. The energy cost is the lesser of the marginal cost of Tri-State's generation fleet or the market price for that hour.

Avoided Cost for projects with a nameplate capacity rating greater than 1.0 MW will be made available upon request with the results influenced by the size, location and operational characteristics of the proposed Qualifying Facility as well as by recent auction (RFP) results.
